If you have logged in before, when you open the app, you will see* the Home page. From here you will see any upcoming appointments that you have booked.

If you wish to book an appointment, tapping the **"Book appointment"** link opens a new screen where you can scroll through the calendar to identify any slots that may suit your requirements.

Individual GP surgeries may offer various appointment types. As of June 2022 The Cranborne Practice offer GP consultations via telephone or face to face to be booked online as well as Health Care Assistant clinics (e.g. routine blood tests, blood pressure checks)
